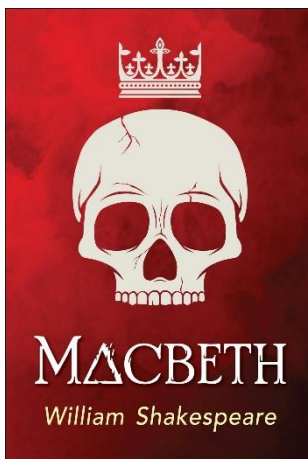

English

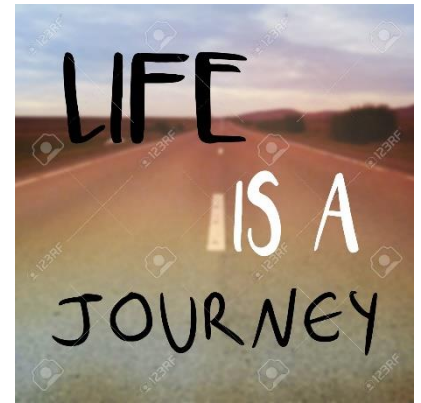

Maths

This half-term we will explore the value of numbers and what each digit is worth. We will compare and order numbers, round numbers as well as add and subtract. We will look at multiplication and division and continue to build on long multiplication and division methods. We will finish the half-term by looking at fractions in detail.
