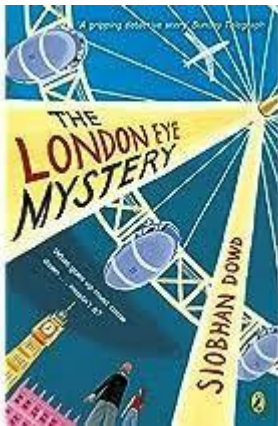




What a fantastic start we have made to Year 6! You are all ready to learn and are a pleasure to have in the classroom.

English



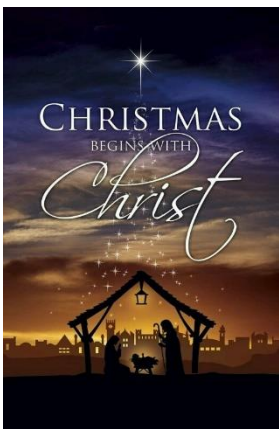
We will begin the half term by reading and exploring the text *The Mystery of the London Eye*. We will discuss the plot of the disappearance in detail and try to be detectives along the way. We will write a missing poster, a diary extract and finish with writing our very own mystery based on Blackpool Tower.

Following this we will link our English lessons to our science where we will create an explanation text on how the circulatory system works.

Maths

This half-term we will be looking deeper into the reasoning side of maths. We will have our first look at algebra as well as learning how to calculate the area of a triangle. We will revisit and build on our knowledge of measures as well as angles.

Geography
